Churches of Christ Thailand (CCT) and Social Development and Services Unit (SDSU), Tewin Somchit

- Those impacted by recent flood disasters. There have been many severe storms and flooding. SDSU staff are closely monitoring the situation in partnership with the local church connections and ensuring ways to practically help those in most immediate need.
- The Church of Christ in Thailand is currently preparing to hold the 37th General Assembly in Chiang Mai. It is expected there will be 710 church leaders from across the country attending this year. The agenda includes important items such as determining the four-year strategy of the CCT for 2023 to 2026 and the election of new church council administrators.
- The SDSU who are currently conducting field surveys in rural communities. The field studies are in preparation for the annual Little Angel project which is a social support programme held in December that provides vulnerable children with gifts for Christmas.
- Community Training Preparation. SDSU is preparing to survey and assess the interest and understanding of community members in both highlands and lowlands regarding training in natural farming techniques, with a goal of leading farming communities towards greater self-reliance and sustainability. In particular, the training looks at ways of reducing the use of chemicals. It is expected that 60 people will attend the training in October.
