FAQ

WHO IS LEADING THE DISCOVERY TRIP?

Global Mission Partners staff members Nick Wight, IMA National Manager. Nick will facilitate the group, and lead the orientation and debriefs. Local partner Juraki will be hosting and facilitating input sessions and activities.

WHO CAN JOIN THE DISCOVERY TRIP?

This Discovery Trip is open to Church groups, leadership teams, study groups, young adults from every part of Australia. This Trip will give participants unique learnings about Indigenous culture, faith, and worldview in a relaxed rural retreat setting. Group sizes are limited to 15 people.

WHERE IS THE EXPERIENCE LOCATED?

Juraki is based on Bunjalung country at Fingal Head on the far north coast of NSW (across the Tweed River from Tweed Heads).

WHAT ARE THE CANCELLATION COSTS?

If a participant pulls out of the Discovery Trip after June 30, 2025, their deposit is non-refundable. Cancellation inside 30 days prior to travel attracts a 50% cancellation fee based on the total participant costs, excluding flights. It is therefore imperative that each traveller has travel insurance in place at the time of full payment so that they are insured for unforeseen cancellation.

ARE THERE AGE RESTRICTIONS?

There are no upper age restrictions for adults on this Discovery Trip, but please note each participant must be in good health with no mobility issues. Applications can be made for children 12 years and over to be included on this trip as part of a family unit but Global Mission Partners reserves the right to deny this request if they feel the overall experience will be compromised. This will be determined on a case-by-case basis.

WHO IS ORGANISING ALL OUR TRAVEL NEEDS?

Participants are responsible for arranging their own flights to and from Gold Coast. All local travel in Queensland and New South Wales will be arranged by Global Mission Partners, and is included in the cost.

WHAT SHOULD I BRING?

Fingal Head weather in August is usually a comfortable 22 degree daytime highs and an average of 10 degrees overnight low. It is advisable to bring casual clothing and personal effects suitable for those temperatures including:

- Warm clothes for outdoors at night, beanies and gloves if desired
- Raincoat or similar in the event of rain
- Walking shoes or similar quality runners
- Toiletries, torch, medications and other personal effects
- Items suitable for beach and water activities
